PHILADELPHIA (August 6, 2025) – <u>GMH Communities</u> (GMH), a vertically integrated real estate company, today announced the opening of <u>ANOVA Aggie Square</u>, a mixed-use building located minutes on the University of California, Davis Sacramento campus along Stockton Boulevard. As the newest development in GMH's nationwide expansion of its <u>Innovative Living</u> portfolio, ANOVA Aggie Square offers a modern residential community tailored to the needs of professionals and students in the life sciences, healthcare and technology fields.

This smart residential community is part of Phase One of the Aggie Square Knowledge Community, which also includes one building designed for science, technology and engineering, a classroom and office building dedicated to lifelong learning, a three-story lab and retail building and a 1500 car parking garage, totaling approximately 800,000 square feet. The Aggie Square project celebrated its official ribbon cutting on May 2, 2025.

ANOVA Aggie Square is a 199,000-square-foot five-story building with 190 student housing and residential units, featuring accommodations for a variety of flexible living opportunities from studios to four-bedroom apartments. Conveniently located on the new Aggie Square UC Davis Sacramento campus and designed to accommodate residents with atypical work and life schedules, this building is retrofitted with amenities like a fitness center and wellness lounge, soundproof working pods, an onsite market and a coffee bar.

ANOVA Aggie Square is the second Innovative Living development completed under the ANOVA name, following the first at <u>ANOVA uCity Square in Philadelphia</u>. GMH is set to open the <u>ANOVA Central Station</u> in Phoenix by Summer 2025, the next expansion of GMH's <u>pipeline of similar innovative living models</u> across the United States.
